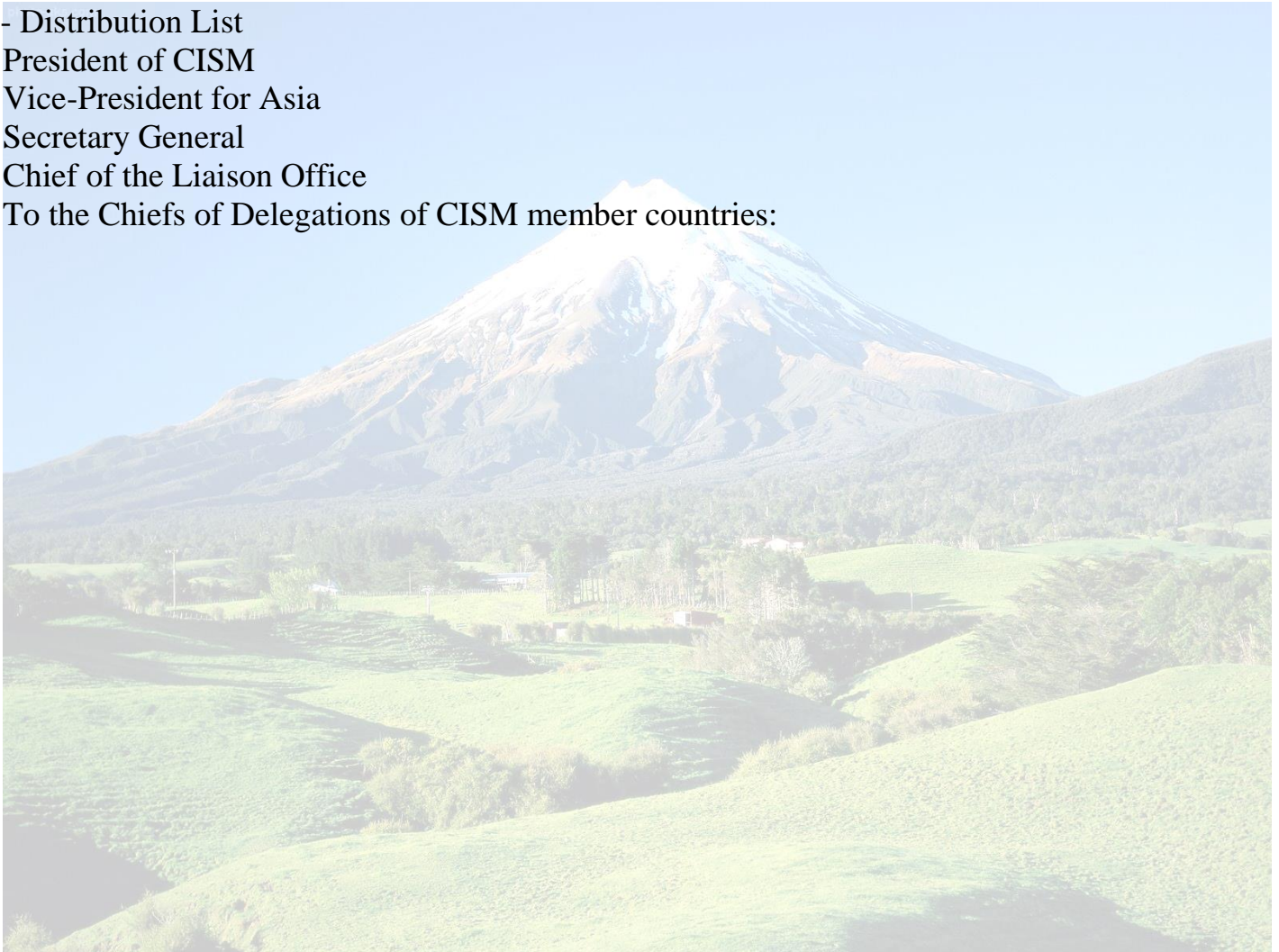

If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event. All delegations are invited but only the first twenty (20) countries will attend. Each interested country will receive a reply email confirming its participation.

2. Program of the Events

(Please respect the arrival and departure dates as they are scheduled after taking into account the long distance road trip from Tehran to Damavand (approx 2 hours).

Day 1) Saturday, 10th Sep2022.

- ❖ Arrival of missions in Tehran/Accommodation in Tehran.

Day 2) Sunday, 11th Sep2022.

- ❖ Opening Ceremony
- ❖ Transportation to Damavand (after the opening ceremony, we will pick you up from Tehran and transfer you to Polour Village).
- ❖ Technical Meeting
- ❖ Departure from Polour to Camp 1 by car (for an hour and a half) and accommodation in Camp 1 and you will take overnight there in the mountain lodge. On this day we will have a simple trekking for acclimatization, overnight in Camp.
 - + Tehran – Polour (2hrs by bus – 70KM)
 - + Polour to C1: 45minutes
 - + Tehran altitude: 1200m to 1400m
 - + Polour Altitude: 2280m
 - + C1 Altitude: 3120m
 - + Trekking duration: 2hrs

Day 3) Monday, 12th Sep2022.

- ❖ After breakfast we will have trekking from C1 to C2, during this day we will climb up slowly to be acclimatized. Around afternoon we will reach to camp 2 and we will rest there. Overnight in Hut/ Camp. (B/L/D)
 - + C1 to C2: 4 to 5 hrs
 - + C2 Altitude: 4250m

Day 4) Tuesday, 13th Sep2022.

- ❖ Climbing from Camp 3 toward the mountaintop (starting from 3 AM for 8 hours)
- ❖ Returning from the mountaintop (starting at 1200 noon) After 5 hours of mountaineering, the mountaineers will rest in Camp 3.

Day 4/ C2 - Summit

- ❖ Early morning around 3am (Depend to weather condition) we will start the summiting.

We will ascend so slowly because we have to touch the mountaintop (5610m) altitude.

- ❖ Then we will descend from the mountaintop, to C2 (starting at 1200 noon) after 5 hours of mountaineering and overnight Camp 2. (B/L/D)

+ C2 to Summit: 8hrs

+ Summit to C2: 3hrs

+ Summit altitude: 5610m

Day 5) Wednesday, 14th Sep2022.

Departure from Camp 2 toward Polour- Tehran (The mountaineers will arrive in Tehran at 7 pm)

Day 6) Thursday, 15th Sep2022.

- ❖ Closing Ceremony.
- ❖ Cultural Day.
- ❖ Exchange gifts

Day 7) Friday, 16th Sep2022.

- ❖ Departures of the missions from Tehran.

NOTE:

- ❖ The equipment for the climbers will be transported from Camp 1 to Camp 2 by helicopter or mule.
- ❖ Climbing is optional for Chief of Delegations. During the event, the use of hot spring mineral water (SPA) in Rine village is planned for CoDs who do not want to climb.

3. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During their stay in Iran, the missions will be guests of the Iran Armed Forces from 10th to 16th of Sep 2022. Full board and lodging will be provided on the organizer's expenses.

- ❖ Extra expenses including telephone, laundry and drinks must be paid by the consumers (participants). Additional people will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizers.
- ❖ The organizers will take care of basic medical support (first aid) and emergency treatments.
- ❖ In case of additional treatment, hospitalization and/or routine medical care, participating nations will be responsible for the payment thereof.
- ❖ Nations arriving before 10th Sep 2022 and departing after 17th Sep 2022 will be responsible for all expenses incurred during the period outside the official competition dates.
- ❖ In accordance with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or and religious activity during the competition, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, clothing, brochures, reviews etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention will result in immediate exclusion and deportation of such nation.
- ❖ Women's participation in these competitions will be subject to the laws and regulations of the Islamic Republic of Iran, and it is mandatory for everyone to observe Islamic dress (Sample images are provided at the end of invitation file).
- ❖ Event will be conducted according to Iranian Government and local area COVID19 -restrictions. Organizer will inform participating countries about specific restrictions immediately after Final entry. [\(General issues related to Covid 19 are mentioned at the end of the invitation file\).](#)

4. Composition of the Mission - (3 Total).

1. Chief of Mission (Preferably the Chief of Delegation).
2. Male or female athletes.

(Only military personnel on active duty will participate. (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.23, item 'A' refers).

Priority of participation will be given to the first twenty (20) from CISM members.

The total number of countries that will be participating in the event is twenty (20).

5. Access to the location of the Competition

Point of Arrival and Departure:

By air: Tehran International Airport (Imam Khomeini International Airport).

- ❖ The event will take place in Damavand Mount, Tehran, Iran, which is two hour away from the Imam Khomeini International Airport.
- ❖ The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating missions.
- ❖ Teams shall arrive at the Imam Khomeini International Airport, to be welcomed by the host's site coordinators and be transported to the site of the event and accommodations.

6. Event Information

- ❖ Damavand Mountain is 5610 meters high and the twelfth highest peak in the world and also the highest volcanic peak in the Middle East
- ❖ It is located in the north of Iran, 74 km from Tehran.
- ❖ Temperatures drop below zero degrees in summer to minus 60 degrees in winter.
- ❖ Downfall in the highlands is usually snowy. Wind speeds vary from 70 km at the foot of the mountain to 150 km. The temperature in September in Damavand peak varies between -5 to -10, but we will not face snow, blizzards and freezing temperatures. (Except for the 100 meters leading to the top of the peak where the ground is usually covered with ice)
- ❖ Damavand is considered as a national natural monument and one of the prominent symbols of Iran.
- ❖ Damavand is a semi-active volcanic mountain.
- ❖ The natural landscape of the area is very beautiful. Unique scenery including ice waterfall (at an altitude of 5100 meters), numerous springs and rivers will be seen by climbers along the way.
- ❖ There are more than 20 routes to climb Damavand Peak, the southern route (the easiest route) is provided for this event.
- ❖ The air pressure at Damavand Peak is half of the pressure at sea level.
- ❖ Not only professional climbers are recommended to climb the peak, and anyone who is in good physical condition can accompany this climb. However, it is better the participants to be professionals.

❖ As mentioned, we are not dealing with rocks, snow and blizzards in this season, the entire mountaineering route is very beautiful and pristine with natural landscapes, for better climbing, participants need to be in the good physical condition and have winter equipment and also medical supplies to prevent any acclimatization and acute mountain sickness (AMS), although the host country will provide the necessary medical equipment.

❖ All participants are required to bring individual climbing equipment including:

(Mountaineering CHECKLIST: Warm socks (2/3 pairs) -Merino leggings (warm) -Fleece leggings - T shirts - Crocs/tent mules (when in base camp or in the high camp) -Warm Merino base layer tops -Fleece or synthetic mid layer -light down jacket -Gore-tex jacket -Gore-tex pants (or wind stopper pants) -Two pairs of gloves (mid weight and down insulated) -Sun glasses - Sun hat -45L Alpine pack -70-100L Expedition duffle (for use up to base camp) - poles -3 season sleeping bag -Sleeping mattress (we will have blanket in local houses and light matt in the huts) -Flask -Bottle (Nalgene) -Hydration system (insulated) -Hand warmers -Warm hat -Neck gaiter or buff -Balaclava(optional) -Head lamp -Compeed Blister kit -Sun cream 30+ or 50 -Water bottle -Personal Medication)

❖ **Need to Know**

If you want to climb Mt. Damavand you need to have the ability of 8hrs walk in the Mountains, although it's not necessary for all trekking days but it's the maximum walking hours.

If you live in sea-level countries and you are eager to climb Damavand, it's better to have acclimatization up to 1000 meters in your country. It's possible to be acclimatized up to 4000m in the mountains of north Tehran.

❖ It is also very important to keep in mind that it is not a race but it is a climbing declaration of Peace and all participants together will carry the flags of their nations and CISM flag toward the peak and in fact, the unique, full pleasure and friendship event is ahead.

❖ Participants in this event will be awarded a Damavand Mount Conquest Certification.

- ❖ Participating Missions are required to bring your their nations flag and their respective national anthem in a CD version.

9. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES.

It is highly recommended that each participating nation contacts the embassy of I.R Iran in their respective country for specific information regarding to entry procedures and VISA information into the Iran. Failure to do so may cause refused entry into I.R Iran.

10. WEATHER.

The anticipated weather for Sep in Tehran is mild and comfortable with low possibility of rain.

Highest daily temperature + 17 c Normal daily temperature +14 --- +16°C. Lowest daily temperature 14°C.

Tehran

Highest daily temperature: + 32 ° C.

Normal daily temperature: +24..+32 °C.

Lowest daily temperature: +24°C.

Polour

Highest daily temperature: + 27°C.

Normal daily temperature: +16..+27°C.

Lowest daily temperature: h+16°C.

Damavand Mount

Highest daily temperature: + 4°C

Normal daily temperature: -10 to +4°C

Lowest daily temperature: -10°C

NOTE: The air temperature in the mountains and altitudes is unpredictable and the temperature mentioned in Mount Damavand is related to last year.

13. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND PREVENTION.

Please note that the "Climbing for Peace" event will be organized following the CISM COVID –19 Guidelines, as well as the I.R of Iran regulations from the Iran health authorities. The following guidelines have been issued by CISM Iran using the collective feedback of different stakeholders in the all sport and have been reviewed by the Iranian Mountaineering Federation and the Health Department of the Iranian Armed Forces. The guidelines will be updated continuously according to the latest information from the World Health Organization and the research/ publications that are released on this topic. The event will look different from what we are all used to. Some of the measures will have an impact on how the event looks like. Here are the measures that will be in effect:

- ❖ Pre-travel Health Checks for all personal Staff will be held to ensure exclusion of those with potential additional risks.
- ❖ PCR test and vaccination certificate could be requested by regional authorities on the arrival to Iran. A Pre-event medical Test (Antigen) for COVID 19 will be mandatory. It will be done by CISM Iran medical service. In case of positive Test, the athlete will not be allowed to participate in WMC.
- ❖ Temperature checks will be required to access the venue and access will not be allowed to anyone with high temperature, or symptoms of COVID.
- ❖ Face mask is mandatory in enclosed areas.
- ❖ Due to COVID restrictions, Opening and Closing Ceremonies may be reduced to the minimum required national representatives.
- ❖ In case of symptoms suggestive of acute respiratory illness before, during or after travel, the athletes are encouraged to seek medical attention and share travel history with CISM Iran.

Individual Responsibility:

- ❖ Participants should aim to keep at least two meters distance from other people.
- ❖ Frequent hand washing by participants using soap and hot water or alcohol-based (at least 65–70%) hand rub for 20 seconds.
- ❖ Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
- ❖ Participants in this event must monitor their health status continuously (including taking their temperature and monitoring for any symptoms) from 14 days before and during the event.

M. Eligibility

Competitors must be military personnel on active duty in their respective countries, with valid military identity cards (Article 7.23 (Participation – Military Status), Chapter 7, CISM Regulations, Edition July 2021).

ANNEX c

FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION

NATION :

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declares that he has read the **CISM Regulations** and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

Article 1.10. RIGHTS OF MEMBER NATIONS

A. Active member nations have the right to:
Be invited to all CISM Championships.

B. Inactive member nations have the same rights as active member nations except that:
They do not participate in any CISM event until they have met their financial obligations.

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

Article 7.23. PARTICIPATION - MILITARY STATUS

A. Only military personnel on active duty in Armed Forces may take part in competitions organized by CISM.

B. No one may be recalled to active duty in the Armed Forces for the purpose of participating in a CISM competition. In the case of an intermittent military service, the athletes regularly recalled may not take part in CISM competitions, under any circumstances, if more than 18 months have elapsed between this recall and the end of their last call to arms.

C. Exceptions to the above may be authorized by the General Assembly, upon recommendation of the Board of Directors.

D. All military participants in a CISM event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active military service of the member nation he represents. The documentation can be:

1. A valid military identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their military identity cards abroad.
2. A form of verification (in English and/or French) of military status accompanied by a passport.

E. **By signing the final entry, the Chief of Delegation confirms the military status of the participating athletes.** If there are last minute changes in the participation of the athletes, the verification file may be signed by the Chief of Mission, but shall be confirmed by the Chief of Delegation by official letter.

F. If one of these documents is not available, participation is refused.

Article 7.32. CHIEF OF MISSION

A. Chief of Mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of A Mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. Respect for schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by a friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in the competition. The mission, which does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorized to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative (OCR) will communicate this decision.

Article 8.6. ABSENCE OF A MISSION WITHOUT NOTIFICATION

If a mission that submits a preliminary agreement and/or final entry is absent without notifying the host nation in time, a sanction will be imposed (Regulations Art. 1.12).

Article 8.17. RULES OF STAY

A. General

1. The Chiefs of Mission are responsible for the discipline of their mission. The missions fall under the jurisdiction of the organizing nation. During events, all athletes present on the playing fields are equal before the jury, the referees and to themselves. No one may use his rank to impose his views on sports matters.
2. Civilian members of the missions shall conform to the discipline accepted by all other participants.

B. Military Uniforms

1. All participants shall wear military uniform during official ceremonies such as the opening and closing ceremonies and medal-awarding ceremonies. **Individuals without proper uniform will not be allowed to participate in the event.**

2. The presentation of medals takes place, in principle, during the closing ceremony. The presentation of medals may be done in sports uniform, if for organizational reasons it is not possible to wear military uniforms. This is the case e.g. when the presentation immediately follows a championship sports event. Sports uniforms shall respect the corresponding national criteria (training suit, sports shoes, etc). Displaying the national flag on the podium by the recipient (athlete or team) at a medal awarding ceremony is forbidden. Individuals failing to respect these prescriptions shall not receive their medal(s) during the official ceremonies.

C. Forbidden Actions

1. In conformity with the statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious propaganda during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden.

2. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition and may result in additional sanctions (Regulations Art. 1.12).

Article 8.19. ACCOMMODATIONS

D. All missions, including those of the host nation, shall be accommodated under the same conditions. If the conditions are in accordance with the CISM norms and standards, the missions are expected to accept the accommodation provided by the organizing nation.

Any mission that does not accept the accommodations provided by the organizing nation and judged as adequate will not be allowed to participate in the event.

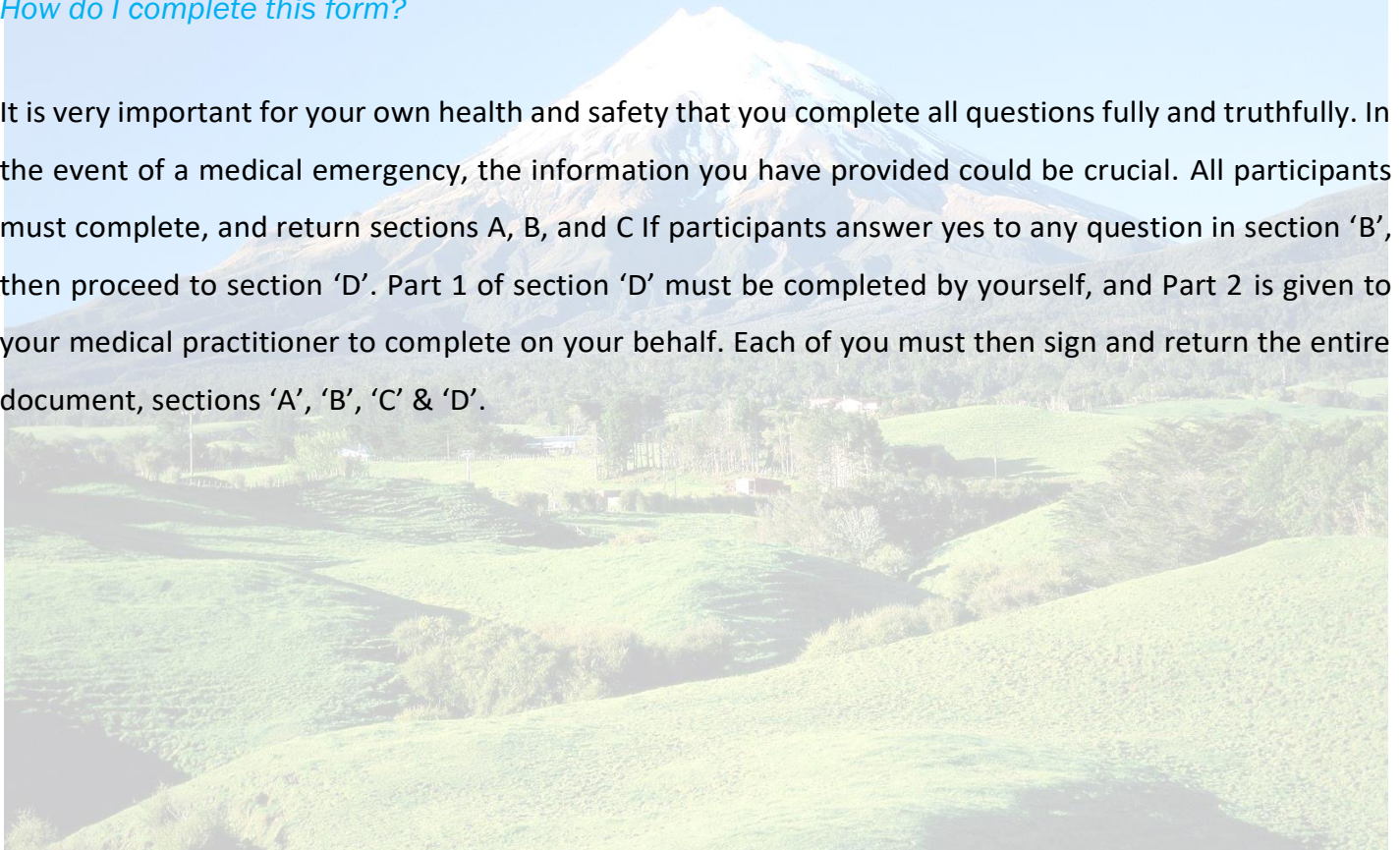

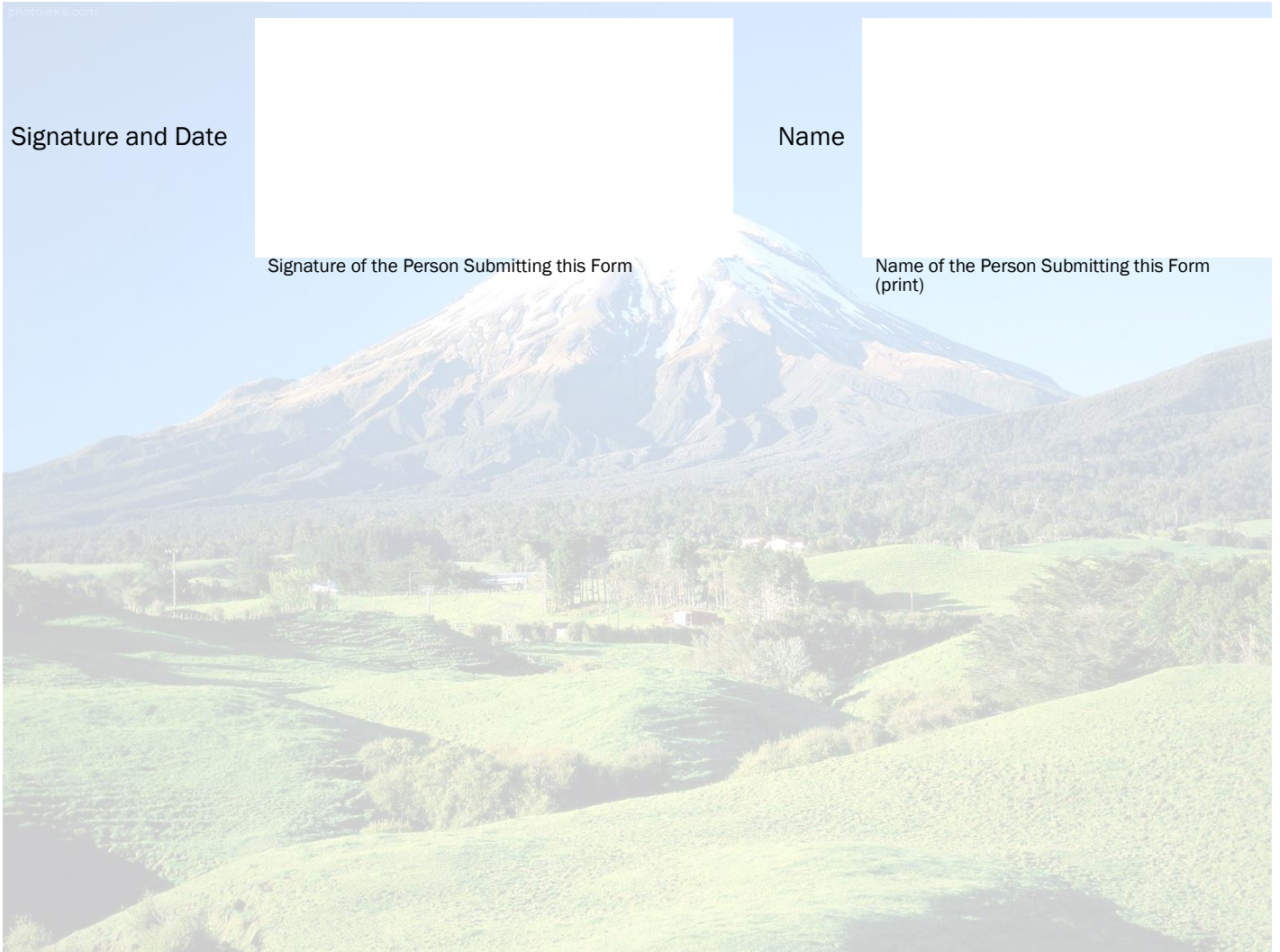

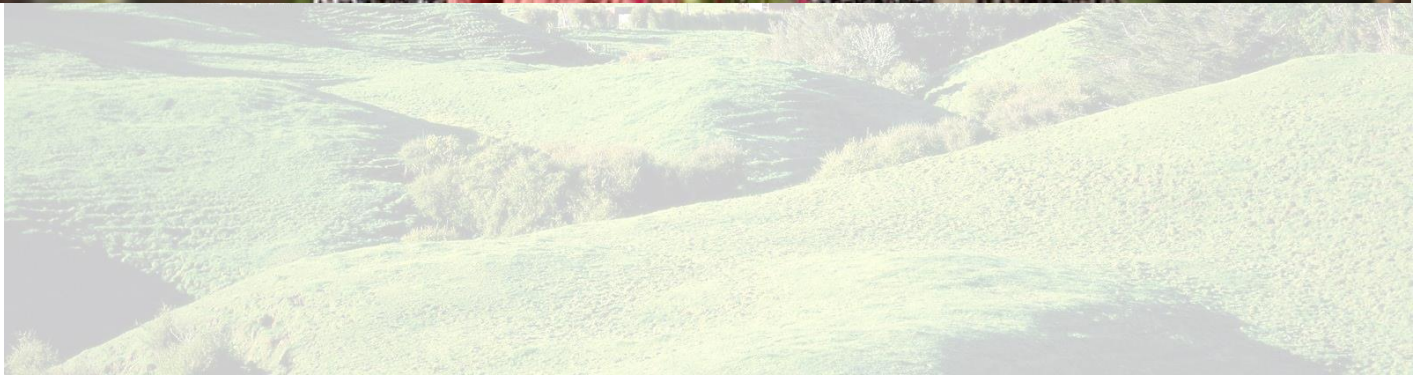
