

All CISM member nations are warmly invited and strongly encouraged to participate in this World Championship.

2. Right to participate in the 14th CISM World Military Football (women) Championship

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 14th CISM World Military Football (women) Championship from 27 June until 9 July 2023 in the Netherlands. An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the World Military Championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

3. Participation criteria

The procedures for nomination of teams for the participation in the 14th MWC Football (women) in the Netherlands.

The Netherlands will host, for the first time in CISM history, the championship with 12 female teams.

Responsible for the nomination of team from the different continents are the continental Vice Presidents.

Nominations for MWC with 12 teams

- 1. Host nation (NLD) counting as one place for Europe
- 2. Winner last MWC (FRA) counting as one place for Europe
- 3. Africa: 3 Nations 3 places for nomination
- 4. Americas: 3 Nations 3 places for nomination
- 5. Asia: 3 Nations 3 places for nomination
- 6. Europe: 3 Nations 1 place for nomination

Should a continent not be able to fill its places with nations, the PCSC in coordination with the CISM Headquarters will decide on the distribution of the vacant places to the other continents.

5. Composition of the mission

**Only for the countries that have approved members on the CISM Sport Committee (CSC) Football. CSC members are not included in maximum number of participants. The CSC members are the only personnel permitted to arrive 2 days earlier to oversee/coordinate the final preparations prior to the commencement of the competition.

***Each country has to bring in 1 referee and 1 assistant referee, it's mandatory.

According to the CISM Regulations, Edition December 2021, Article 7.23, item A and item D only military personnel in active duty and in possession of a valid military ID card may participate in the competition.

Additional visitors will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizing committee. The costs for board and lodging are at their own expenses.





6. Access to the location of the competition

The location of the competition is the sports park De Westmaat in Bunschoten-Spakenburg. Travelling expenses, to and from The Netherlands, will be the responsibility of the participating country.

The organizing committee will provide round-trip transportation from the place of arrival to the place of stay in The Netherlands and the transport during the competition.

Places of arrival and departure (see enclosed map):

7. Conditions of stay

During their stay in The Netherlands the missions will be guests of The Netherlands Armed Forces from 27 June until 9 July 2023.

Board and lodging will be provided by the organizing committee and is free of charge. Mission members will be accommodated in a hotel. Additional food & beverage and special requirements (telephone, laundry, etc.) are not included.

Nations arriving before 27 June '23 and departing after 9 July '23 will be responsible for all expenses incurred during the period outside the official competition dates.

8. Food and beverage

The use of bottled water is not necessary. Tap water is safe to drink. Menus are widely varied.

If you need diet and religion-related requirements, please let us know in the final agreement.





9. Medical support

The Netherlands will take care of medical support (first aid) on site. Further costs for medical support are at the expense of the participants. Participants health insurance must be valid in The Netherlands and a copy must be handed over if applicable.

10. Regulations of the championship

The championship will be governed by the CISM Regulations (Edition December 2021) and CISM anti-doping Regulations.

The competition will be played on artificial grass.

11. Anti-doping

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.

The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).

In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

12. Uniforms

Service uniform is mandatory for the opening- and closing ceremony, summer dress will be sufficient. For COM is service dress A mandatory.

14. Customs and visa procedures

For information regarding passport and visas for entry into The Netherlands, please contact The Netherlands embassy in your country or the respective embassy serving your country in The Netherlands.

Make sure, that you apply for your visa in time!

15. Weather conditions and additional information

- 1. The temperature in June/July in The Netherlands is between 18°C 30°C. Average temperature is about 23° C. Average water temperature is 16° C. The probability for rain is at 35%.
- 2. The currency used in The Netherlands is the EURO.
- 3. The location of the competition will be Bunschoten-Spakenburg. The distance from Amsterdam to Bunschoten-Spakenburg will be 45 km.
