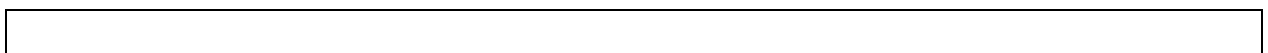

Only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competitions (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.23, item A.).

D. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE COMPETITION.

- The competition will take place in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, at the “Yunusobod” sport complex which is ~ 45 minutes away from the Islam Karimov International Airport, ~ 20 minutes away from the “Shimoliy, Janubiy” railway station or “Tashkent” bus station ~ 40 minutes
- The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating missions.
- Teams shall arrive to the I.Karimov International Airport, “Shimoliy, Janubiy” railway station or “Tashkent” bus station, be met by the host site coordinators and be transported to the site of the competition and accommodations.

E. CONDITIONS OF STAY.

Participations missions will be the guests of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The cost of travel to the point of arrival and from the point of departure in Uzbekistan is responsible of participating missions.

Organizers will provide the transportation during the official dates of competitions.

Those Missions that arrive before and depart after the official dates of competitions will be responsible for all expenses incurring during their stay out of the official dates of the competitions.

In accordance with the Status, Regulations and Traditions of CISM, any political or religious actions during the competitions, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, clothing, brochures, reviews, etc., is strictly forbidden. Any contravention will result in immediate exclusion and departure of such mission.

Additional people will not be accepted without official writing permission of the Organizers.

Participants will be requested to pay their extra expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, additional food and beverages.

Medical support (basic emergency treatment - first aid) during the competitions will be provided by organizers. Any special treatment, surgical operations, routine care and hospitalization will be responsible of participating mission.

F. REGULATIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

The competitions will be conducted with the CISM Regulations, CISM Judo Regulations in conjunction with the most updated International Judo Federation (IJF) Rules, to be presented and discussed during the Preliminary meeting will apply throughout.

As if the IJF Rules will be changed before the 42nd CISM WMC Championship, the renewed version of rules will be announced during the Preliminary meeting and will applied for the event. In case of arising of any contentious issues the CISM Regulations will be prevail.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT.

Weight Categories shall comply with the adopted IGF International Rules.

Weight categories are:

Men: 60 kg, 66 kg, 73 kg, 81 kg, 90 kg, 100 kg, +100 kg.

Women: 48 kg, 52 kg, 57 kg, 63 kg, 70 kg, 78 kg, +78 kg.

G. ANTI-DOPING.



Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the

International Standard for Testing.

The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).

In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

H. UNIFORM.

During the official events such as Opening and Closing ceremonies all participants are obliged to be in Military uniform. Autumn military uniform class A.

Formal suit is requested during the Technical / Preliminary meeting and media briefings.

Sport attire marked with country name may be worn outside the ceremonial events.



I. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES.

It is highly recommended that All participating missions contacts the embassy of the Republic of Uzbekistan in their respective countries for specific information concerning entry procedures and VISAs information.

In order to avoid problems with deadlines for granting Visas adopted by different countries and embassies, we recommend that participants contact the Embassy of the host country in their own country and schedule an appointment **soon after sending the Preliminary Agreement.**

J. WEATHER CONDITIONS.

The anticipated weather for October in Tashkent is mild and comfortable with low possibility of rain.

K. CURRENCY.

The local currency is the uzbek sum.
