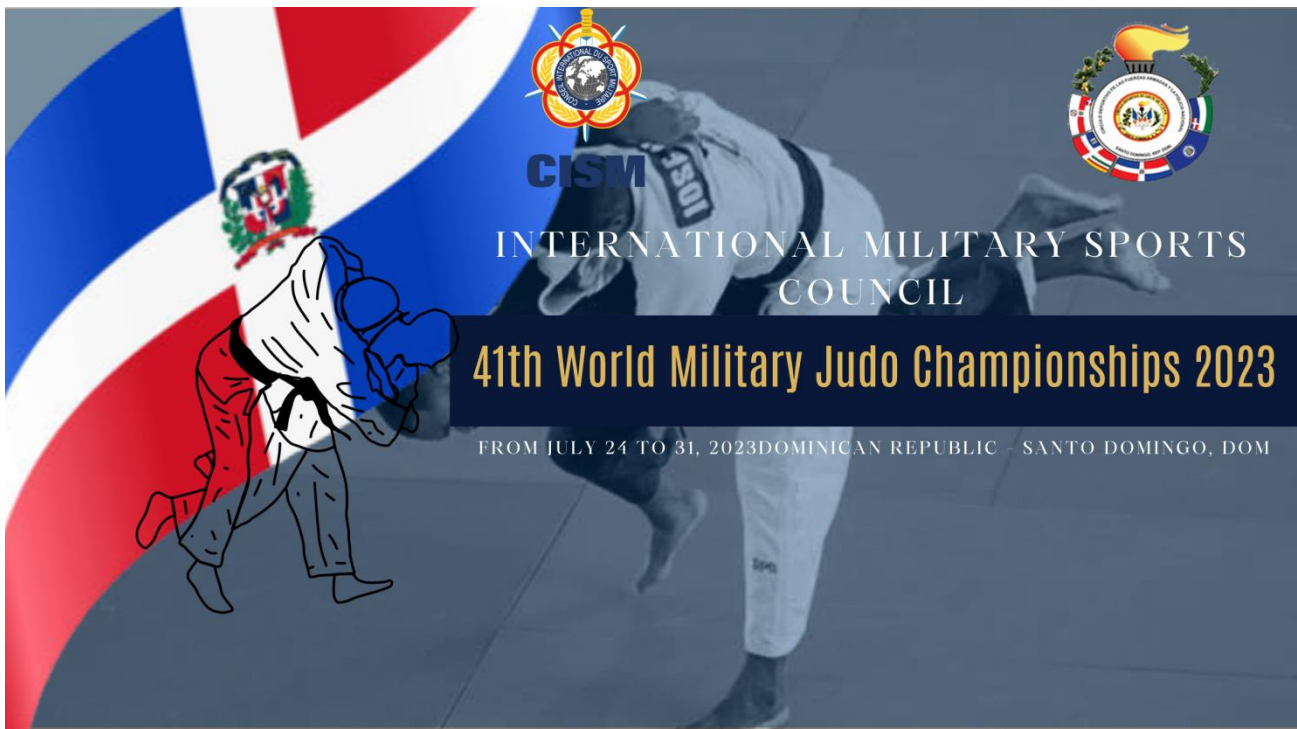

**A. Right to participate in the 41<sup>st</sup> CISM World Military Judo Championship**

Only active CISM member nations have the right to participate in the 41<sup>st</sup> World Military Judo Championship.

An inactive nation, which intends to participate in the event, must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the Military World Championship, for the final registration event. Otherwise, the delegation will not be able to participate in the aforementioned event.

## Notes:

- If the number of judokas in each group of men and women is 5 or more than 5, the delegations can have 3 coaches (1 main coach and 2 coaches), otherwise, for the group of men and women they will have 1 coach ( in total 2 trainers).
- Each delegation must include in the composition of its delegation up to two International Referee Licenses. If 2 arbitrators from the same country are announced and sent, at least one of them must have a World Class International Arbitration A License (IJF-A).
- Only military personnel on active duty may participate in the competitions (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.21, item A.).
- Only delegations that register a Full Team, minimum 6 competitors (1 for each division, maximum 2 per division) may participate in the mixed team tournament.
- Athlete, man or woman, injured (physical or psychic) during active service and autonomous in its displacements.
- Only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competitions (CISM Regulations, Art. 7.21, item A.). Disabled athletes are not submitted to the obligation of active duty, decision voted during the last AG.

## C. Access to the location of the competition (Dominican Republic).

- The cost of travel to the Dominican Republic and respective return will be covered by each participating country.
- The Organizing Committee is responsible for round trip local transportation, from the official pick-up point to the place of accommodation and during the development of the competition.
- This transportation service (including airport transfers) is only offered on days when the delegations are booked in the official accommodation, through the organizers. If the delegation does not meet the transportation deadline, the organizers are not obliged to provide airport or bus transfers.
- To enter and leave the Dominican Republic, each person must present the migratory QR code, which is obtained through the link <https://eticket.migracion.gob.do>
- The arrival of the delegations must be through the Las Americas International Airport "Doctor Jose Francisco Peña Gomez"

## G. Conditions of stay

- During their stay, the missions are guests of the Delegation of the Dominican Republic to CISM.
- The event will take place in the Volleyball Pavilion – Juan Pablo Duarte Olympic Center.



- Food and lodging will be provided for all participants, as well as transportation for all CISM-related events.
  - Nations that arrive after the corresponding dates will be responsible for all expenses incurred during the period outside the official competition dates and must coordinate in advance with the OC.
  - Participants must cover any costs before and/or after the dates they have previously informed the Organizer.
  - According to the CISM Statutes, Regulations and Traditions, any political or religious action during the competition, in particular, the dissemination of propaganda documents, images, clothing, brochures, reviews, etc., is strictly prohibited. Any contravention will result in immediate exclusion and deportation from said nation.
  - Additional persons will not be accepted without the official written permission of the CO, or additional companions will be required to pay for their own accommodation.
  - Medical emergencies (first aid) will be in charge of the CO. Routine medical care will be provided for each mission. The organizer will provide medical support during all scheduled competitions, only at the emergency level.

- All participants must travel with their own medical coverage and/or inherent insurance.
  - Special medical treatment will be under the responsibility of the participating nations.
  - Participants who ask for services not covered by the Organizers, such as telephone calls, drinks, laundry etc. must pay the respective extra expenses.

**The CO is NOT responsible for:**

- Hospitalizations;
- Surgical operations or other special treatments;
- Repatriation in case of death due to illness or accident;
- Other expenses due to illness/accident such as compensation, loss of earnings, etc.
- The local currency is the Dominican peso RD\$ or DOP\$.

**H. Championship Regulation**

- CISM Regulations, December 2021 Edition.
- The CISM Judo Regulations (2021 Edition) will be applied along with the most up-to-date Rules of the International Judo

Federation (IJF), which will be presented and discussed at the preliminary meeting. The latest version of the CISM Judo Sport Regulations can be retrieved at: <http://www.milsport.one/sports/judo>.

- The FIP Rules can be changed before the championships, so it will be the last rules that will apply for the 41st CISM World Military Judo Championships and will be announced at the preliminary meeting.
- In case of conflict, the CISM Regulations will prevail.
- The team competition will take place after the individual competition.

## I. Anti-doping

- Anti-doping tests will be carried out in accordance with the CISM Anti-Doping Symbol, CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the corresponding CISM Sport Regulations, the corresponding International Federation Rules and all the rules of WADA, mainly the World Anti-Doping Law. -Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
- The number and type of controls, as well as the athletes to be controlled, will be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the corresponding CISM Evidence Distribution Plan (TDP).
- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Head of Delegation must send this TUE to the CISM SG up to 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be sent to the TUE Commission for analysis and subsequent approval.

## K. Uniform



- Class A Uniform is mandatory for ceremonies. All participants must wear military uniform for the opening ceremonies. Civilians will wear appropriate formal attire during ceremonies. No uniform, no ceremony.
- All participants must wear a Class A uniform for the closing ceremonies. Civilians will wear appropriate formal attire during ceremonies. No uniform, no ceremony.
- During the Preliminary/Technical meeting, military uniform or formal attire (jacket, pants, shirt and tie for men; jacket, pants/skirt/dress, blouse for women) and formal shoes are required.
- Missions are requested to bring a national flag (0.75 m x 1.50 m) and their respective National Anthem on a CD or MP3.I file. Customs and Visa Procedures.
- For the competitions they must comply with the regulatory measures and wear their official judogui according to the International Judo Rules.
- For the medal discussion, the coaches must have their military suit.
- For the award ceremony, each competitor must present himself with the uniform that represents his institution.

## **K. Enrollment Deadlines**

- Preliminary Agreement (Annex 1) No later than: 03/01/2023.
- Final entry (Annex 2a), composition of the mission (Annex 2c) and commitment of the Head of Mission (Annex 3): no later than: 05/30/2023.
- The participating delegation must inform valid telephone and fax numbers in the final agreement form, as well as their email address in case the organizing committee needs to get in touch.
